### **Monroe County Fair Horse Shows**

August 6, 2016

Hunter/English Show ~ Saturday @ 9:00 am

Western Show (including Ranch Riding) ~ Saturday @ following English (no earlier than Noon)

#### **EQUINE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:**

- Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) is not required for NYS horses. CVI *is* required for imported horses.
- Negative Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) test is required for all horses 6 months of age or older. A valid negative EIA must accompany all horses. The test must have been conducted during the current or previous calendar years for NYS horses. For imported horses, the test must be conducted within 12 months of entry.
- The EIA test certificate must include a complete description of the horse.
- Current rabies vaccination is required for all horses 16 weeks of age or older.
- Papers **will** be checked.

#### **EXHIBITOR INFORMATION:**

- Questions may be directed to the Horse Superintendent. See General Rules published in the exhibitor handbook for more information including contact information.
- Entry fee allows for one rider and one groom **only** to enter fair grounds without a pass and use the exhibitor only trailer driveway. **All others must purchase a ticket to enter fairgrounds** during fair hours and use the regular fair visitor parking lot across the street.
- Entry fees and rules specific to disciplines are listed with each show.
- No one other than exhibitors may ride, school or train a horse entered in the show while at fair. Exceptions may be made by request to the superintendent. Safety will always be of primary concern.
- All exhibitors must have their show numbers visibly displayed at all times when mounted or in the show ring.
- Protests are to be lodged with the horse superintendent, who will then determine whether to approach the judge.
- No parent, coach, visitor or exhibitor may approach, questions, or direct public comment to or about the judge. Violations will be handled on an individual basis by the Horse Superintendent and Show Committee.
- Good sportsmanship is a must!
- No dogs allowed on the grounds.
- No stabling available.
- No stallions permitted in youth or lead-line classes.
- Proper equestrian footwear must be worn.
- All exhibitors under the age of 18 and those entered in jumping classes must wear an ASTM-SEI approved helmet. (ASTM-1163/SEI or ASTM-F-1163-04a SEI).
- Youth riders are defined as a rider who is at least 8 years old and under 19 years old as of January 1, 2015.
- An approved helmet and equestrian footwear must be worn by youth at all times when mounted, riding in a vehicle being pulled by one or more equines and when youth are in the show ring.
- Superintendent reserves the right to combine or cancel classes.
- All classes pinned 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> with the exception of lead-line in which participation rosettes will be received.
- Points towards champion and reserve champion are based on points received by placement: 7 pts for 1<sup>st</sup> place, 5 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, etc.
