Rules & Regulations

- The fair has a new location at 6565 East River Rd, Rush, NY 14543 (easy access from Rts 90 & 390).
- Please review General Rules for Exhibitors, where there is also superintendent contact information.
- Competition is open to all.
- Multiple entries accepted. No exhibitors shall receive more than two premiums for any one class.
- **Entry fee** is \$1 for single classes, \$1.25 for litter classes, and \$.50 for pet classes, **due by 7/31**. No entry fee for Monroe County youth.
- Entry fee includes feed provided by the fair for the animals while they are on the grounds.
- Late entries subject to a late fee of \$10 per exhibitor.
- No refunds, day-of-show substitutions are allowed.
- Mail entry forms & entry fee check to Monroe County Fair, 20 Office Park Way Suite 131 Pittsford, NY 14534.
- No animal will be allowed in the fair without a health check.
- Any diseased or unsightly specimen will be rejected by the superintendent or veterinarian at any time before or during the show. Exhibitor will be asked to remove specimen from show area.
- Exhibitors can bring animals to the fair Friday, 8/4 from 9am-11am.
- Animals will be released Sunday, 8/6 at 6pm. Exhibitors should plan on helping clean-up exhibit area.
- Classes for sexes & breed varieties provided as recognized by the American Rabbit Breeders Assoc.
- All breeds will be shown in color patterns only. Individual colors allowed only if listed in the Standard of Perfection.
- Adults and Youth animals will be shown together. Youth exhibitors will be awarded within their class. There is no separate youth show.
- All animals present must be entered in their proper classes and sections to be eligible for judging.
- All rabbits must have a permanent tattoo in the left ear.
- Angora Breeders must provide their own wire bottoms for cages. Cages are 21' x 20-1/4".
- Coop identification cards must remain on coops at all times.
- Owner or show personnel are the only ones allowed to handle the animals.
- Owners may feed and water their own stock. Please provide feed dishes and water bottles.
- Stacking cages will not be allowed unless provided by the fair.
- Animal sales will be handled through the show superintendent. Only the animals entered in the show may be sold. All transactions will be managed by the superintendent and paperwork / money will be provided to the seller at the end of the fair. Pedigrees for any animals will be left with the superintendent to provide to the buyer. There will be a sales board posted prominently.
- There is a 20% commission on all sales and it will be collected by the superintendent.

Section **TT**

1. Doe With Litter Class

- Exhibitors must furnish their own cages.
- Cage should be one square-foot per pound weight of doe and should be clean and presentable.
- Litter class will be judged by the number of young present and their condition and uniform size. Doe must be in good condition.

Section **PR**

1. Pet Class
