#### **Rules & Regulations**

- The fair has a new location at 6565 East River Rd, Rush, NY 14543 (easy access from Rts 90 & 390).
- Please review General Rules for Exhibitors, where there is also superintendent contact information.
- Competition is open to all. The terms percentage and purebred (including fullbloods) refer to the amount of Boer blood.
- Multiple entries accepted. No exhibitors shall receive more than two premiums for any one class.
- Entry fee is **\$3 per class, due by 7/31** (postmarked). No entry fee for showmanship or market kid classes, or for Monroe County youth.
- Late entries, including day-of-show, subject to a late fee of \$10 per exhibitor.
- No refunds, day-of-show substitutions are allowed.
- Mail entry forms & entry fee check to Monroe County Fair, 20 Office Park Way Suite 131 Pittsford, NY 14534.
- No animal will be allowed to unload without health check.
- Exhibitors can bring animals to the fair Saturday, 8/5 starting at 9am and must be in place by 11am.
- Animals will be released Saturday 8/5 at 6pm or when the show ends, whichever is later.
- Please bring a shovel or other tools to help clean up your pens at end of show.
- Superintendent may combine or cancel classes if needed.
- The base date for computing age is August 5th.
- The Monroe County Fair requires that all goats four months of age or older on the day of arrival be **vaccinated against rabies**, as permitted by NYS Ag & Markets rules.
- All goats **MUST have** scrapie tags, or tattoos with matching registration papers brought to the show.
- Please identify the goat entered in a class on the entry form. (Name/number and scrapie tag or registered tattoo).
- If your goat is tattooed, please be sure the tattoo is clearly legible before entering the ring.

#### Showmanship Classes

1. Novice Showperson: 8 years old and under
2. Junior Showperson: 9 yrs through 13 yrs
3. Senior Showperson: 14 yrs through 19 yrs
  - 3a. Champion & Reserve Showperson

**Market Kid Classes** - Owned & showed by youth. Market kids may not be shown in breed classes. (To be divided by weight at show; middle weight class may be added if entry numbers warrant it).

1. Lightweight Market Kid (usually under 60lbs)
2. Heavyweight Market Kid (usually over 60lbs)
  - 2a. Champion & Reserve Market Kid – Rosettes

#### Junior Doe Classes

3. 1 – under 3 months: born 5/6 to 7/5, 2017
4. 3 – under 6 months: born 2/6 to 5/5, 2017
5. 6 – under 9 months: born 11/6, 2016 to 2/5, 2017
6. 9 – under 12 months: born 8/6, 2015 to 11/5, 2016
  - 6a. Champion & Reserve Junior Doe – Rosettes

#### Yearling Doe Classes

7. 12 – under 16 months: born 4/6, 2016 to 8/5, 2016
8. 16 – under 20 months: born 12/6, 2015 to 4/5, 2016
9. 20 – under 24 months: born 8/6, 2015 to 12/5, 2015
  - 9a. Champion & Reserve Yearling Doe – Rosettes

#### Senior Doe Classes

10. 2 years – under 3 years: born 8/6, 2014 to 8/5, 2015
11. 3 years – under 4 years: born 8/6, 2013 to 8/5, 2014
12. 4 years – and up: born on or before 8/6, 2013
  - 12a. Champion & Reserve Senior Doe – Rosettes

#### Junior Buck Classes (Fullblood/Purebred only)

13. 1 – under 3 months: born 5/6 to 7/5, 2017
14. 3 – under 6 months: born 2/6 to 5/5, 2017
15. 6 – under 9 months: born 11/6, 2016 to 2/5, 2017
16. 9 – under 12 months: born 8/6, 2015 to 11/5, 2016
  - 16a. Champion & Reserve Junior Buck – Rosettes

#### Grand Champion Class
