Rules & Regulations

- The fair has a new location at 6565 East River Rd, Rush, NY 14543 (easy access from Rts 90 & 390).
- Please review General Rules for Exhibitors, where there is also superintendent contact information.
- The show is open to all ADGA registered and recognized purebred, American, and Grade does.
- Multiple entries accepted. No exhibitors shall receive more than two premiums for any one class.
- Entry fee is \$3 per class, due by 7/31. No entry fee for Showmanship classes.
- Late entries, including day-of-show additions, subject to a late fee of \$10 per exhibitor. Pre-entry is strongly encouraged to ensure that enough pens are available.
- No refunds, day-of-show substitutions are allowed.
- Mail entry forms & entry fee check to Monroe County Fair, 20 Office Park Way Suite 131 Pittsford, NY 14534.
- Exhibitors can bring animals to the fair Sunday 8/6 starting at 9am and must be in place by 11am.
- Animals will be released Sunday 8/6 at 6pm or at the end of the show, whichever is later.
- Official ADGA rules will govern the show. Junior and Senior does are not separately sanctioned.
- The show is sanctioned by ADGA for the following breeds, in the order to be shown: Alpine, LaMancha, Nubian, Saanen, Toggenburg, All Other Purebred, Recorded Grade.
- The order of the show is not subject to change.
- No horns allowed.
- The base date for computing age is August 6th, 2017.
- No animal will be allowed to unload without health check.
- The Monroe County Fair requires that all goats four months of age or older on the day of arrival be **vaccinated against rabies**, as permitted by NYS Ag & Markets rules.
- The original registration certificate is required for all animals **four** months of age or older and must be shown to the show secretary before the start of the show. No copies, faxes or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the aforementioned.
- Please identify the animal entered in a class on the entry form (name and tattoo).
- Specialty classes will be broken down according to breed and all animals in these classes must be entered in the regular classes.
- Make sure that the tattoo on your goat is clear before entering the ring.
- No pre-show milk out.
